SAFEGUARDING TRAINING

Everyone who works with children and young people in our church is required to attend Safeguarding Training organised by the Presbyterian Church every 3 years. Courses are now being run at a Presbytery level, rather than at individual level. We will be hosting a course in our premises on behalf of East Belfast Presbytery on **Wednesday 21 October 2026 at 7.30-9.30 pm.**

ACCESSNI RENEWAL

All those working directly with children and young people in churches within PCI are now required to renew their AccessNI vetting every 3 years. As this has just been recently introduced, the majority of leader/helpers in our church now need to complete re-vetting by completing a PCI AccessNI form, along with an online application directly to AccessNI. Over the next few weeks packs will be given to Leaders in charge of organisations to distribute to their leaders/helpers in their organisations. Those working in more than one organisation only need to make one application, listing the organisations in which they are involved. Originals of the two ID documents which are uploaded on the online application need to be provided for checking. A guidance sheet is enclosed in the packs.
